Tuition In-State Students 2013-2014 Fall & Spring Semesters and Summer Term	Tuition for full-time, in-state students carrying 16 or more semester credit hours will not exceed \$1,144.00 plus fees per semester or term. Part-time students and those taking less than 16 hours will pay \$71.50 plus fees per semester hour. (5 Semesters)	\$5,720.00
Tuition Out-of-State Students 2013-2014 Fall & Spring Semesters and Summer Term	Tuition for full-time, out-of-state students carrying 16 or more semester credit hours will not exceed \$4,216.00 plus fees per semester or term. Part-time students and those taking less than 16 hours will pay \$263.50 plus fees per semester hour. (5 Semesters)	\$21,080.00
Activity Fee	There is a \$3.25 per credit hour (maximum \$32.50) activity fee charged for all students enrolled in the fall semester and spring semester with the exception of high school students. This includes the cost of SGA, intramural activities, and other designated student activities and events. This fee is charged for fall and spring semesters only. (4 Semesters)	\$130.00
Campus Access Fee	There is a \$15.00 campus access fee charged fall and spring semesters and summer term. This fee is charged to all students enrolled in curriculum courses with the exception of high school students and those eligible for fee waivers. (4 Semesters)	\$60.00
Technology Fee	A Technology Fee of \$4.00 per credit hour (maximum \$16.00) will be charged for each fall and spring semesters and summer term. This fee is charged to all students enrolled in a curriculum course with the exception of high school students. (5 Semesters)	\$80.00
Insurance	Coverage All curriculum students, with the exception of high school students, enrolled are charged a student insurance fee of \$1.25 fall and spring semesters and summer term. This fee covers the students with the school accident insurance policy.	\$2.50
Malpractice Insurance	Students enrolled in the Associate Degree Radiography program must purchase the college's malpractice insurance (\$17.00). This is charged each fall semester for coverage during the school year. The insurance must be purchased prior to students doing any clinical work. This coverage protects the students and the college while the students are in their clinical courses of study.	\$34.00
Books	The cost of books is approximately \$800.00-\$1000.00 first three semesters and \$400.00-\$500.00 last two semesters.	\$1,500.00
Commencement Fee	Graduation fee is charged to all students and covers graduation regalia and degree.	\$55.00
Student Medical Form	Applicants accepted into the program must submit a student medical form which must be completed by a physician, physician assistant, or nurse practitioner.	\$100.00
AHA BLS Certification	American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers provides individuals training in CPR, AED and relieving choking. Payable to AHA sponsor.	\$80.00
Background Check and Drug Screen	Applicants admitted to the program will be required to submit background checks and drug screening as directed by affiliating clinical agencies. Payable to On-Premise Solutions, LLC	\$85.00
Uniforms, Lab Coat, & Shoes	\$40-\$60 per uniform (3 uniforms per student), one lab coat, and two pairs of shoes.	\$350.00
Lead Identification Markers	Lead identification markers with student initials. (2 sets)	\$65.00
ARRT Certification Exam	American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Primary Certification Examination. This certification is typically required for employment in the profession. Payable to ARRT just prior to graduation.	\$200.00
BRSRT Membership	Blue Ridge Society of Radiologic Technologists is a regional professional society and offers student membership. (Annual fee of \$5.00 for two years) Payable to BRSRT	\$10.00
NCSRT Membership and Annual Meeting	North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists is a state professional society and offers student membership and holds an annual state meeting. (Annual fee of student membership and state meeting registration for two years) Payable to NCSRT	\$260.00
ASRT Membership (optional)	American Society of Radiologic Technologist is the premier professional organization for radiologic science professionals and offers student membership. Payable to ASRT	\$35.00
